PROPOSED RESOLUTION 1 ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDS

Submitted by: Pacific Northwest District Board of Trustees

Vote required to pass: Majority

Note 1: The Board of Trustees has asked the House of Delegates to consider this resolution. Because it would be a significant shift in policy for this organization, the Board wants the delegates to decide for themselves how to vote; the Board is not making a recommendation on how to vote.

Note 2: The current rule is that no funds from the public can be used for administrative purposes. Even if the resolution passes, the current rule will remain in place. If the resolution passes, the Kiwanis International Board would be asked to consider the policy change.

Given that the demographics of this organization have changed and current members are not as able as past members to fund this organization through their dues; and

Given that our organization competes with many reputable charities and non-profits that derive the bulk of their funding from contributions from the public; and

Given that increased Administrative funds would help clubs provide lower dues and increase support to members and leaders who attend conventions and leadership training sessions, lower dues;

Therefore be it resolved that the Pacific Northwest District calls on Kiwanis International to allow clubs to use up to 10% of funds raised in the community for administrative costs that support the continued success of the club.
