Qualifying Levels

Platinum Level – 70 points Gold Level – 60 points Silver Level – 50 points Bronze Level – 40 points.

The Governor's Challenge "Club of Choice" Award - This is a special recognition for clubs reaching Gold or Platinum levels and have maintained club membership at 30 or higher from January 1 to September 30, 2009

The Governor's Challenge "Proud of Our Club" Award – This is a special recognition award for clubs that were less than charter strength at October 1, 2008 and have reached Silver or higher level and have **returned the club to Charter Status (25) by March 31, 2009 and maintained 25 or more members until September 30, 2009**
