**The Governor's Challenge "Proud of Our Club" Award** – This is a special recognition award for clubs that were less than charter strength at October 1, 2008 and have reached Silver or higher level and have **returned the club to Charter Status (25) by March 31, 2009 and maintained 25 or more members until September 30, 2009**
