



## Banner Patch Guidelines

Fund raising events can be done at the Club, Division, or Zone level.

Have a KCCP presentation be the Club program at your regular Club meeting.

Consider inviting other civic organizations to your Club's meeting when the program is presented. Invite these organizations to join or partner with you in an event or events to raise funds for the program.

To earn Club Honor Roll Status, from Club Fundraising, the equivalence will be contributing \$50.00 per Member (that's less than one dollar per Member per Week for a year) to one of the Kiwanis Programs: Doernbecher's Children Hospital, Seattle Children's Hospital, or BC Children's Hospital. Our goal is to raise at least \$500,000 District wide. Your official membership number is Members as of October 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. Honor Roll Status will be an Elite Group with special privileges at the District Convention.

To receive the Banner Patch requires at least 50% of your Clubs total money commitment. Example: if your Club has twenty Members your donation would be at least \$500.

Earn a banner patch for YCPO as all three hospitals treat newborns and young children.
